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Checklist for Admission to the MPH Program

Requirements for Admission

1. Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher on a scale of 4.0
2. Combined GRE score of 1000 or higher for verbal and quantitative sections. Requirement may be waived for applicants who already hold a graduate or professional degree from U.S. and/or other accredited universities.
3. TOEFL score of at least 100 (internet) or 600 (paper-based) for applicants whose native language is not English for regular admission; provisional admission may be granted for scores between 79-99 (550-599) and an English Proficiency Test is required upon enrollment.
4. One year of health-related experience in a health-career setting is preferred.

Additional Requirements for International Students

- ___ Affidavit of Financial Support within 9 months of desired entry
- ___ TOEFL Scores

Application Process

1. Complete Graduate School Application on-line
2. Send application fee to Graduate School or pay on-line
3. Send all other application materials to the MPH Program office.

Application Deadlines

International Students

- 1 February** – for Fall semester enrollment
- 1 August** – for Spring semester enrollment
- 1 December** – for Summer semester enrollment

Domestic Students

Applications are accepted all year round but are desired at least **3 months before** the semester you wish to enroll. Note that processing may take 4-6 weeks so plan accordingly.
